



Dear Friend of the Anti-Choice Project,

Let us not kid ourselves but instead be frank: November 6, 2012 was not a good day for unborn babies. The most radically pro-abortion president in all of U.S. history was re-elected to a second term, during which he will likely name one (or more) additional Supreme Court Justices to the 9-member bench.

While the pro-life/pro-abortion split of the bench hangs precariously in the balance, any replacements made by President Obama will most certainly be staunch defenders of the court's worst decision, Roe vs. Wade, handed down 40 years ago this January.

What America needs is a president whose first criteria for judicial appointments is to exclude from consideration any man or woman who cannot recognize the right to life – which comes from God and not the state – of all human beings. But we can never hope for such a president so long as we remain a country composed almost entirely of citizens who are to one degree or another indifferent to the plight of those 3,500 babies who will be tortured to death today. And we can never hope to be a nation shaken from our indifference so long as pro-life activists continue to hide the disturbing truth of abortion.

When abortion is hidden, abortion is tolerated. But the very sight of abortion is so intolerable, so upsetting, that even the most calloused and hardened are outraged. To look upon abortion is to become sickened by the depravity and barbarity of the act. It is to experience the same sickening feeling we all felt on December 14th when we learned Adam Lanza had murdered twenty school children. Only, in a certain sense, abortion is far worse than Sandy Hook since approximately 200 times as many children were dismembered by abortion the day Adam Lanza opened fire in an elementary school. So, in this country you could say we experience 200 Sandy Hooks daily, except that in lieu of a daily national outcry Americans have for 40 years reacted with hardly more than a yawn.



In January, the ACP stood with several thousand pro-lifers at the annual March for Life in Olympia, WA, this time with two large 5 x 10 ft banners encouraging pro-lifers to expose abortion in their communities.

There was no need for the media to run images of Sandy Hook victims. Those children were quite real to us and without any effort we imagined the gruesome horror of that scene which still today brings tears to our eyes. The horror of abortion, however, is not so easily imagined because the victims are not real to us. Their screams are never heard. Their broken bodies are never seen. Our sewer lines run red with their blood, our garbage dumps house their remains, but unlike the Newtown massacre the media run no stories on children killed in the womb.

How does one protest against an injustice of such magnitude but in which the victims are never seen, are never heard, are never so much as given the dignity of being named?

Answer: One has to make the indescribable evil of abortion real to complacent Americans. One must enter

into the windowless abortion mills with a camera to document the hidden horror taking place behind sterile, closed doors. That evidence, which can only be communicated properly through our sense of sight, has to be broadcast via as many mass-media outlets as possible.

If print and broadcast media have lost all integrity and refuse to expose the evil, then effective reformers are left only to use the most traditional of mass-media venues: the public square. If – as a movement of social reform – we fail to accomplish even that, then we have no reason to hope for any reversal of Roe in the next 40 years.
