As yet another year draws to a close with little legal help to speak of for unborn children scheduled to die, we at the Anti-Choice Project recommit ourselves to changing minds and saving lives — to exposing abortion in all its gruesome horror in the public square so that it can never be trivialized or ignored.

Nothing in life changes until the pain of same exceeds the pain of change. Wherever we take our abortion victim photos, we bring tremendous pain to bear on the complicit and complacent consciences of those who see us. Many who see us are angry. It stands to reason that the majority of those who are visibly angry with us are so because of an abortion they procured, or, worse, pressured a woman into procuring. Being confronted with the sheer inhumanity of what they have already compartmentalized and rationalized away as “the lesser of two evils,” they often lash out at the messenger.

People always want to attack the messenger when they are confronted with some moral truth challenging their immoral behavior. No Christian should be surprised by this since Truth Himself was crucified by the world 20 centuries ago. Like Christ, effective social reformers are always blamed first and exonerated later. We do not care about our exoneration; we do not care one bit what people think of us. We care only what they think of abortion. And on that matter we are having a tremendous impact. We know we are effective because of the outrage — the “blame” — we receive every time we show people images of abortion victims.

## ACP LINCOLN CRASHES PLANNED PARENTHOOD EVENT

Late September in Nebraska the local ACP chapter joined forces with Lincoln Right to Life to protest outside a Planned Parenthood training event which was being held for Lincoln Public School District teachers regarding “gender issues.” Planned Parenthood uses such opportunities to get their propaganda into the veins of the public education system and ultimately help them sell more abortions. But at this event, upon arrival, the teachers quickly realized they were being educated on more than they had bargained for. They were met by a team of ACP volunteers, each equipped with a sign and brochures exposing Planned Parenthood’s “bottom line”.

## ABORTION VICTIM IMAGERY SUMMIT

In May of this year we were honored to receive a letter from Eric Scheidler, Executive Director of the Pro-Life Action League, which is based in Chicago. Eric is the son of Joe Scheidler, known affectionately in the movement as, “the

Father of Pro-Life Activism.” The reason for the letter from the Pro-Life Action League was to propose a summit of pro-life leaders in the US and Canada who could work together in advancing the widespread use of abortion victim imagery. The meeting took place in Chicago on September 19, 2013 and was a huge success. In addition to the Scheidlers, other notables at the conference were Jill Stanek (JillStanek.com), Stephanie Gray (Executive Director, Canadian Centre for Bio-Ethical Reform), Mark Harrington (Created Equal), Dr. Monica Miller (professor of Sacred Theology and author of Abandoned: The Untold Story of the Abortion Wars), Tom Brejcha (President and Chief Council, Thomas More Law Society), and Fr. Frank Pavone (National Director, Priests for Life).

While our street demonstrations remain the heart of our mission and strategy in exposing the truth of abortion to Americans, ACP is always looking for new and effective ways of reaching even more people. At the Chicago meeting we were able to learn about some of the strategies being employed by other activists using the images of abortion. One of the more effective strategies currently being used by the Canadian Centre for Bio-Ethical Reform is the distribution of postcards with abortion victim photos on one side, and pro-life text on the other. This is a particularly powerful tool as it is a very cost-effective method of reaching people in the quiet of their homes and presenting them with a compelling and logical case for the rights of pre-born human beings alongside the photographic evidence that abortion kills babies. The Anti-Choice Project will be implementing this strategy in the coming months.
