It is stunning, is it not, just how quickly the world seems to be spiraling out of control? From the advancement of ISIS and the daily headlines of new Islamic terror attacks, to the crumbling of traditional marriage in our own culture, to our crooked and incompetent government bureaucrats, to the indoctrination of Leftist ideology in our schools, to the growing hostility against all Christian morality, it would seem that this nation is in many ways on the verge of collapse.

DNC CELEBRATES THEIR ABORTIONS

And as November 2016 draws near we are reminded of the impending disaster that a Hillary Clinton presidency would bring. Indeed, the Democratic party as a whole today not only defends, but embraces and celebrates the act of killing a child in the womb. On May 12, 2016, under the leadership of Lauren Handy, volunteers with our ACP Washington, D.C. chapter braved the cold and rain to reach high school students who desperately needed to be shown the truth about abortion.

Year after year, polls show the country steadily growing more pro-life and supportive of restrictions on abortion, yet the Democratic party only grows more extreme on the issue. This year, the party adopted a platform which calls for a repeal of the Hyde Amendment, which prohibits the use of taxpayer funds for abortion, as well as any state or federal law which restricts a woman's "access to abortion". You will frequently see the positions of the party "evolve" as the culture moves to the left on social issues such as same-sex marriage and transgender bathrooms, but as the culture becomes more pro-life, Democrats dig their heels in the sand in order to protect their precious right to kill unborn children.
