Dear Friend of the Anti-Choice Project,

This year has begun as perhaps the most promising for the pro-life movement since 1973. Not only do we have pro-life majorities in the U.S. House of Representatives and the Senate, but also a pro-life president and vice president. Many questions were still looming after the November elections as to whether a President Trump would in fact make good on his campaign promises to pro-lifers. But after just a few weeks of moving into the White House it is clear he will. Consider the following:

1) Trump has nominated Neil Gorsuch to fill the vacant seat of the late Antonin Scalia on the Supreme Court.

As an appellate judge, Gorsuch was a strong supporter of religious freedom and ruled in favor of Hobby Lobby and the Little Sisters of the Poor, against the Obamacare mandate of paying for contraception and abortifacients. Gorsuch has also said, "All human beings are intrinsically valuable and the intentional taking of human life by private persons is always wrong." Ilyse Hogue, the president of NARAL is beside herself with this nomination: "Gorsuch represents an existential threat to legal abortion in the United States and must never wear the robes of a Supreme Court justice."

2) On February 1, 2017, the Senate confirmed Jeff Sessions as the nation's new Attorney General. In Sessions we have a bold and unwavering advocate for the unborn. Sessions has said, "I firmly believe that *Roe v. Wade* and its descendants represent one of the worst, colossally erroneous Supreme Court decisions of all time."

3) On Day-1 President Donald Trump signed an executive order reinstating the Mexico City Policy, which bars international non-governmental organizations that perform or promote abortions from receiving US government funding. "The President, it's no secret, has made it very clear that he's a pro-life president," White House Press Secretary Sean Spicer told reporters at his first daily briefing.

2017 MARCH FOR LIFE IN WASHINGTON, D.C.

ACP co-director Tom Herring flew from Seattle to D.C. to attend the annual March for Life. Tom was present to hear Vice President Mike Pence's historic address to the crowd: "At 1600 Pennsylvania Avenue, we are in the business of keeping promises...[the President] asked me to thank you for your support...be assured, be assured, that along with you, we will not grow weary, we will not rest until we restore a culture of life in America for ourselves and our posterity."

ACP was also invited to participate in a strategic planning meeting with other powerful activists in the pro-life movement. Tom met with Troy Newman of Operation Rescue, Mark Harrington of Created Equal, Eric Scheidler of Pro-Life Action League, Jonathan Van Maren of the Canadian Center for Bio-Ethical Reform, Andrew Moore of the Susan B. Anthony List and others. At the March, Tom also had a chance to speak briefly with David Daleiden of the Center for Medical Progress. David gained

international attention after he recorded a series of undercover videos exposing the American abortion industry's practice of selling aborted baby body parts.

ACP DC IN SOLIDARITY WITH THE BABIES KILLED


